Beginner's Knitting 2 - Thursday, January 19, 6 – 8 p.m.

Clare Tarr will present how to add additional colors to your knitting project, how to create stitch patterns with the knit and purl stitch (stitches taught in Beginner's Knitting), and a new stitch: the double wrap. Students with basic knitting knowledge are encouraged to attend.

Supplies: Attendees will need to bring their own size 9 or 10 knitting needles to the workshop (prices range from \$2 - \$10). Yarn will be provided by Clare Tarr.

Colored Pencil - Saturday, January 7, 1-3 p.m.

Artist Diana Fair will demonstrate and guide participants through the steps of executing a colored pencil drawing. Participants will explore the medium of colored pencil while Diana explains the basics and discusses technique. Diana will present various tools, types of pencils and papers. Participants will be

given the opportunity to start a colored pencil drawing during the workshop. Diana has a Masters of Education degree and has been working in colored pencil for the past 40 years. She has shown works in the International Exhibition of Colored Pencil Artists three times. Appropriate for ages 15 through adults.

Supplies: Attendees will need to bring their own 12 or 24 set of Prismacolor colored pencils. They will also need a drawing pencil (2B) and a kneaded eraser. Some drawing boards are available but students are encouraged to bring their own if possible. A photo for drawing reference will also be needed. Artlink or Diana will provide all other materials needed for the workshop.





Presentation: Graphic Alchemy – Sunday, January 8, 2 – 4 p.m.

Mixed-media artist Justin Johnson (Gallery Director – University of Saint Francis) will present a lecture visually describing in detail his approach to the technique of his work. By using acrylic washes, found surfaces, graphite, and liquid gold on glass, he creates works with visual and textural depth. He will also present artistic influences as well as a brief gallery walk-through of his works which are part of the Regional Award Winners Exhibition on display at Artlink from December 9 – January 11.

Gesture in Charcoal - Saturday, January 14, 10 a.m. – 1 p.m.

Artlink's Suzanne Galazka will explain the importance and value of Gesture Drawing to the artist. Appropriate for ages 16 and over. Nude model will be utilized. Using charcoal, experience a lesson in eye-hand coordination and learning to understand how to interpret a figure in space on a one-dimensional surface. Exercises are from Kimon Nicolaides' *The Natural Way to Draw*. Come dressed to make art – charcoal is messy.

Drawing from a Narrative Source - Saturday, January 21, 10 a.m. – 1 p.m.

Art Cislo will demonstrate how to create a work of art using a narrative source. Attendees will learn to interpret and visually respond to their own favorite poem, text, or other narrative source. Beginning with a series of sketches and then with pencils and different inks. Art currently teaches drawing at the University of Saint Francis. Drawing from a narrative source is one of Art's specialties, among many!

Supplies: Attendees should bring their own HB and/or 2B drawing pencil and a favorite poem, text, or other narrative source. All other supplies will be provided.



Drawing the Human Head: Mass Conception - Saturday, January 21, 2 p.m. – 5 p.m.

Artist and Professor Chris Ganz will teach Drawing the Human Head: Mass Conception. He will teach a volumetric approach to drawing the head focusing on overall form, plane changes, and proportion. Chris is an Associate Professor of drawing and printmaking at IPFW and shows at the Ann Nathan Gallery in Chicago. See examples of his work at ChrisGanz.com. Appropriate for ages 16 through adult.
